- Status of NumFocus
 - Transitioning to dissolve the USA Foundation of Bioconductor NA
- Defining a “Bioconductor Treasurer” to interact with NumFocus

:10 - :12 Pro-slack cannot continue

- Free slack means no extended history
- We can grab an archive for public channels but not for Private or DM
- Can we combine with the support site rollover to discourse this will consolidate some of the communication outlets?
- Zulip was suggested on slack
- Matrix might also be an alternative; talk with Galaxy at the conference as they may be using it.
- Also self-hosted mattermost might be yet another alternative.

- Core is investigating moving support site from biostars backend to discourse for improved maintenance and security

:15 - :21 Defining and Contributing to Bioconductor when listing in grant

- Defining a line item for Bioconductor in grants
- Listing appropriate funding if involving Bioconductor core
- Consulting agreements
- In EU: <5K no issues, 5-50K need 3 tenders
 - Maybe a standard write up to justify funding for Bioconductor
- EOSS/R03
 - Consulting agreements (up to \$5K is typically no add'l paperwork)
 - Standard mechanism / boilerplate as with EU would be useful
 - Carpentries approach ("coordinate if you want an LoS") as model?

:22 - :31 Alternative Funding to Bioconductor

- Corporate Sponsors, Can we get Industry Involved?
 - The Industry Working group has gone inactive
- Outside Grants that we can apply?
- NumFocus should/could help with corporate or donations
- Pharma: push to move towards open source, R packages, etc. might be a good opportunity for collaboration
