

**NAME**

CURLOPT\_PUT – make a HTTP PUT request

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_PUT, long put);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

A parameter set to 1 tells the library to use HTTP PUT to transfer data. The data should be set with *CURLOPT\_READDATA(3)* and *CURLOPT\_INFILESIZE(3)*.

This option is **deprecated** since version 7.12.1. Use *CURLOPT\_UPLOAD(3)*!
